DISCLOSURES AND INFORMED CONSENT

In order to comply with current state regulations regarding the practice of naturopathic medicine issued by Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies, we must ask patients to read and sign the following:

Dr. Brenna Hatami provides office consultations to patients as a service. As of June, 2014 Dr. Hatami is registered as a naturopathic doctor in Colorado (registration #000009) and has been licensed as a naturopathic physician in Vermont since 1997 (license # 0000029).

Naturopathic doctors registered by the state of Colorado to practice naturopathic medicine under the "Naturopathic Doctor Act". Under this law, they are not permitted to perform the following acts:

- Prescribe, dispense, administer or inject any prescription medications or devices other than epinephrine for anaphylaxis and barrier contraceptives (not including IUD's).
- Perform surgical procedures, including procedures using a laser device.
- Use general or spinal anesthetics, other than topical anesthetics.
- Administer ionizing radioactive substances for therapeutic purposes.
- Treat a child who is less than two years old.
- Treat a child who is two years of age or older, but less than eight years of age unless;
 - (1) this form is fully completed and signed
 - (2) the most recent immunization schedule recommended by the advisory committee on immunization practices to the centers for disease control and prevention in the federal department of health and human services is provided to the parent with this form.
 - (3) a release of information is provided to the parent or guardian requesting permission to exchange information with the child's licensed pediatric health care provider, if the child has one.
- Practice obstetrics.
- Perform chiropractic services (spinal adjustments, manipulation or mobilization). Physical medicine as prescribed in 12-37.3-102(12)(b), C.R.S., is permitted
- Recommend the discontinuation or counsel against a course of care, including a prescription drug that was recommended by another health care provider licensed in Colorado, unless the Naturopathic Doctor consults with the health care provider.

SERVICES: Naturopathic Medicine is a branch of the healing arts distinct from other branches. Our services include the prevention, evaluation, diagnosis and treatment of injuries, diseases and conditions through education, nutrition, naturopathic preparations, natural medicine, physical agents and other therapies and modalities designed to support the body's natural healing processes. Naturopathic Doctors are registered under the Colorado Naturopathic Doctors Act. They are not Medical Doctors (MD), Doctors of Osteopathy (DO), Doctors of Chiropractic (DC) or Doctors of Nursing (DNP) who are licensed under separate practice acts.

RISKS: Naturopathic Medicine is generally considered safe but may involve some risks including, without limit: all of the risks disclosed with any preparations or medicines; allergic reaction, infection, pain or discomfort, weakness, fainting, nausea, skin irritation,(including discoloration or scaring) aggravation of symptoms, mood changes and rarely neurological injury and pneumothorax. Naturopathic Medicine may adversely interact with specific drugs and may be inappropriate during pregnancy. Naturopathic manual therapies involve risks including, without limit, fractures, disc injuries, dislocations and sprains. Additionally, hidden conditions may exist that are not detectable through examination.

EMERGENCIES: If you are having a medical emergency, do not wait to seek care. Call 911.

NO GUARANTEE: Every individual responds to care differently and no guarantee or assurance is made as to the results of care in any specific case, as care may not improve your condition.

PAYMENT, INSURANCE AND REFUNDS: Payments are due in full at time of service and are not conditional on response to care. There is no guarantee of insurance coverage. I recommend you contact your insurance company and ask if naturopathic services are covered and what is needed. Any insurance you have is an agreement between you and your insurance carrier. You may terminate care at any time. Prepaid services are eligible for a refund within 1 year however, no refunds are available for product purchases.
